We collaborated with a local place of worship and brought in a socially conscious music group.

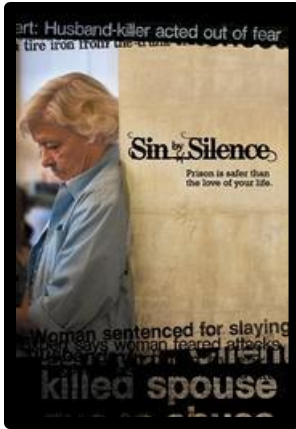
